Steps to Owning an Oiled Wood Floor

European Oak

190mm x 1900mm x 4/15mm 4 sided bevel, click lock

1. Choose a colour.

2. Choose a timber grade

- Hard Wax Oil is a blend of premium quality Natural oils and waxes to give superior protection to interior wooden flooring. Maintaining the natural look of the wood, it forms a highly durable barrier against water, stains, dirt and wear and tear. Providing a long-lasting, smooth and low-odour finish, and is safe for use on toys. Oiled floors have a Matt finish as standard. But Semi-Matt and Satin are options.



Choose your Timber Grade

This guide is given as an indication of grades by opening random boxes, of eight boards, of each grade.

Being a natural product, each box will vary in knots, sapwood and cathedral grain.

The natural tannins in Oak mean variance in colour that in turn produce dark and light coloured boards but with similar tonings.

The beauty and character of wood is that no two boards are the same!

Maintenance

We stock the complete product range for our Oiled European Oak Floors, making repairs and maintenance a breeze! Over time, as the floor is nourished with Maintenance Oil, it develops its own patina, just like an antique piece of furniture does. The timber floor will improve with age by applying Maintenance Oil when needed. There is no need to vacate your home as there is no sanding required. Timber floors add immediate value to your home and the beautiful matt finish of our oiled timber provides a timeless look. It has been a long-standing European tradition to use hard wax oils to create natural looking timber floors that are hard-wearing, elegant and have an authentic 'Old World' look. All flooring is oiled in New Zealand, to order, making your floor bespoke.



Repair

To spot repair, simply apply our non-toxic oil to the scratches and allow to dry.

For deep scratches as in the photo (left), simply use a wire brush, moving with the grain to broaden the area and apply the coloured oil. The oil will blend in beautifully without any lines and is touch dry in only 8 hours.
